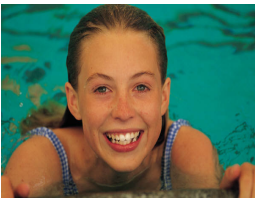


Washington Itinerary

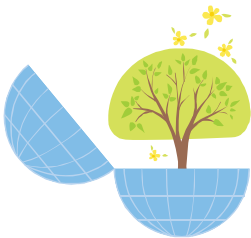
